UNIFORM AND PERSONAL APPEARANCE

HARMONY SCHOOL OF INNOVATION has a uniform policy to help create a safe and orderly environment, instill discipline, and eliminate competition and distractions caused by different dress styles. You will be expected to arrive in dress code every day. Please cooperate, display modesty and neatness, and take pride in these clean, neat and attractive uniforms. We rely on your common sense and your parents' and/or guardians' support in helping maintain this dress code. Most of the uniform items can be purchased from the school and/or from the companies suggested by the school.

PLEASE NOTE...

If you arrive at school out of uniform, your parents will be called. You will be kept out of classes until you are dressed appropriately and all the class time you miss will count as an unexcused absence.

The staff reserves the right to determine and restrict certain styles. If a student is dressed or groomed inappropriately, parents may be called to bring a change of clothes. Violations of the dress guidelines will result in disciplinary action.

OFFICIAL UNIFORM FOR ALL GRADES:

Uniform Top

- Harmony school uniform shirt (must be purchased from the school)

Pants/Skirts

- Elementary (K thru 5th grade) Girls & Boys: Khaki pants. No skirts.
- Middle and high (6th thru 9th grade) Girls: Navy blue pants/skirts (knee length).
- Middle and high (6th thru 9th grade) Boys: Navy blue pants.

Footwear

- **Socks:** White, navy, blue or black (must be worn at all times). No pads or footies.
- **Shoes:** Dark-colored lace-up shoes or loafers (closed toe, closed heel), athletic shoes
- No sandals, mules, ugs, high heels, boots or crocs
- No hee-lies (shoes with wheels)
- All shoes should have backs or secure straps on the heel for safety.
- Shoe laces must be tied at all times.
- No long shoe laces due to safety concerns.
- Shoes must be kept clean at all times.

P.E. UNIFORM POLICY

K thru 3rd grade – Students are required to wear their school uniforms.

4th thru 9th grade – Students may wear a grey t-shirt (no sleeveless/tank tops) and grey shorts (shorts must be below the knee) or grey sweatpants. Students are required to change back to their school uniform after their PE class.

**Note - No spandex or tight fitting t-shirts/shorts/sweatpants will be allowed.

P.E. Uniforms may be purchased at a store of your choice. Also, students in 4th thru 9th grade will be responsible for taking home their uniforms and bringing them back to school on a daily basis. Students will be given time before P.E. to dress into their uniforms.

ADDITIONAL DRESS CODE REQUIREMENTS AND LIMITATIONS

In addition to making sure you are wearing the school uniform, HARMONY SCHOOL OF INNOVATION requires that you follow these additional guidelines in terms of uniform and personal appearance. It is the desire of the administration that students attend school with a neat, conservative, well-groomed, and modest appearance. Some aspects of the dress code are institutional preferences that are deemed reasonable and enforceable. The dress code listed below will encourage young people to maintain good standards of dress as well as allow for comfort, safety, and personal preference in their dress.

Pants and Slacks:

- No jeans.
- No shorts.
- Must fit properly.
- May not be baggy or saggy.
- No low waist pants.
- Pants must be worn properly at waist size.
- No short skirts with leggings.
- May not be cargo style.
- No rolled up pants.
- Belts must fit properly and not hang down when buckled.
- Pants legs may not be rolled.

Personal Appearance:

- No facial and body piercing.
- No Clip-on jewelry (earrings, nose rings, etc.)
- No tattoos.
- No extreme hairstyles (mohawks and spiked-up) and hair colors.
- Sunglasses are not permitted.
- Wallets connected with a long chain are not acceptable because of safety concern.
- No pajamas, PE uniform pants or similar material is acceptable.
- Boys may not wear earrings
- Girls may wear stud earrings.
- Shirts must be tucked in at all times.

Outerwear:

- No hats, caps, bandannas, and other headgear and outerwear such as windbreakers, jean jackets, or ski jackets.
- Jackets, sweater and coats must have a zipper or buttons.
- No pulled over sweat shirts.
- No hoodies.
